- The Okanagan Valley was named as second-best wine region to visit amongst the top 10 worldwide destinations. – *USA Today Readers' Choice Awards 2014* -- Sip and sample along the Naramata Bench, Summerland Bottleneck Drive or Okanagan Falls. More than 50 wineries are within a 20-minute drive of downtown Penticton.

- Voted as the second-best beer Town in Canada. – *Expedia, 2018* - Sample at one of Penticton's many craft breweries and distilleries. Many are in Downtown Penticton!

- Penticton features seven public beaches stretching over five kilometres along two pristine freshwater lakes (Okanagan and Skaha).

### ***Penticton Attractions and Activities***

- Explore the historic SS Sicamous, parked on the beach at Okanagan Lake. It's the largest surviving stern wheeler in BC and sits on one of Penticton's seven public sandy beaches. Together, they stretch over five km long!
- Explore "Colourful Front Street" and Downtown Penticton's shops, restaurants, and galleries.
- Bring your clubs, or rent a set, as the Okanagan Valley offers seven championship and 21 additional courses. Many courses are open year-round.
- Rent a bike or bring a bike and cycle the Kettle Valley Trail, which connects Penticton to Kelowna and Penticton to Okanagan Falls.
- Walk the Kettle Valley Rail Trail or stroll along the picturesque Lakeshore Drive. See the Peach on the beach and pose for a picture.
