If you are pre-registered and have signed the waiver, we will forward a walk direction to you to do as you travel to the event.

Start Times: Friday/Saturday: 8:00am-1:00pm, finish by 4:00pm; Sunday: 8:00am-12:00pm, finish by 3:00pm.

Driving Directions: US20 East and West. The BARN is located on west side of downtown.

Event #1 - Rainy Pass-Rainy Lake/Lake Ann/Maple Pass Loop: North Cascades Area (34 mi. west of Winthrop). Enjoy beautiful lakes, views, and trails. Three lengths: Rainy L 3K Rated 1A; Lake Ann 6K Rated 2C (700 ft. gain); and Maple Pass loop 10K Rated 4C (2000 ft.)

Event #2 - Blue Lake/Cutthroat Lake: Blue Lake is 31 miles West of Winthrop, 7K rated C3 (1050 ft. gain). Cutthroat Lake is 26 miles West of Winthrop, 6K rated 2B (700 ft. gain).

Event #3 – REVISED Mazama Area: Mazama Trails and River Run Trail (13 mi. west of Winthrop). Flat trails. Loop Trail 5K and 10K out and back. River Run Trail 7K.

Event #4 – NEW Big Valley: 5K and 10K.

Event #5 – NEW Lewis Butte and Riser Lake: Lewis Butte 10K. Riser Lake 6K.

Event #6 - REVISED Rex Derr Trail/Lake Pearrygin State Park: Views abound as you walk the trail around the lake. Pick your distance 5K. 8K and 13K.

Event #7 -REVISED Winthrop Town Walk: Explore Winthrop, visit historic museum, and community trail. This walk features a suspension bridge over the Methow River on your way back into town.

Event #8 - REVISED Sun Mountain Trails: Mostly shaded walk in the Sun Mountain trail system. Explore the wooded area, beaver pond, and vistas on the trail.

Event #9 - REVISED Twisp/Pipestone Canyon: Explore historic Twisp 5K. Explore this beautiful Canyon 5K.

Bike the Methow Valley: – Mazama Country roads and fall color. What a grand landscape for biking.
